

Mediapolis Main Street



Project Description:

This was the first phase of the city's Main Street reconstruction. Shoemaker & Haaland recognized the importance of Main Street and its role as the gateway into the community. This reconstruction project widened the existing street from 20 feet to 25 feet and added formal parking areas to improve intersection visibility. One of the great features of this project was the installation of decorative street lighting and planters throughout the corridor and at intersections as a way of inviting people to enter the community. The City has received nothing but positive responses from residents and business owners about this great improvement to their community.

Design Features:

- Construction phasing to keep access to the fire department
- Paved on-street parking
- Streetscape lighting and planting
- 1300 LF of street reconstruction and widening
- Gateway to community business district
